



What is Acryline?

Road markings are essential safety tools that provide information on the road in which we are travelling, they indicate what actions we should or should not be taking.

Adbruf manufactures a range of road marking materials to a high safety standard. A relatively new product to the Adbruf portfolio is Acryline, a extremely durable cold plastic material which is based on a 2 component methyl methacrylate (MMA) resin. Acryline comprises a range of spray and manual application versions; Acryline MV and Acryline MA.



Why Use Acryline?

Acryline has been formulated for use in areas where traffic is constant and durability is crucial. It can be laid quickly, thinly, and has a short curing time, enabling roads to be open to traffic in approximately 30 minutes after application (at 20°). Acryline, with the addition of Adbruf's Retrolux surface beads can provide excellent levels of retroreflectivity improving visibility when driving at night.

Acryline is primarily the product of choice where highly abrasive road conditions exist, such as areas where snowploughs and abrasive winter grit are used. It is also suitable for use on areas where hot applied materials are not permitted for example airports, petrol station forecourts, indoor car parks etc.
